DAY 1 SUNDAY JULY 27 LOS ANGELES/BRUSSELS

Welcome to Munich. Enjoy an afternoon Munich City Panorama Sightseeing Tour highlighting the neo-Gothic Town Hall, the twin onion-topped Frauenkirche, the famed Marienplatz, the Olympic Stadium, Nymphenburg Palace – the Versailles of Bavaria – and Theresienwiese, site of the famous Oktoberfest, and much more. After our sightseeing of Munich, we end at our hotel in Munich for check-in. Balance of the day at leisure. (B)

DAY 9 MONDAY AUGUST 4 MUNICH TO VIENNA

Morning departure from our hotel and we begin a scenic drive through the Bavarian Alps to Berchtesgaden, home of a sinister attraction – Hitler's Kehlsteinhaus, the dictator's infamous mountaintop retreat "Eagle's Nest", with stunning views and scenery. We continue to Salzburg, Austria, one of Europe's most beautiful historic cities and the birthplace of Mozart. Upon arrival in Salzburg, we will have free time for lunch on own, before starting our sightseeing. Afternoon sightseeing of beautiful Salzburg. We will see some of the highlights of this city of castles, horse-drawn carriages and church towers including the Domplatz with Salzburg Cathedral and Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart's birthplace. After our Salzburg Panorama City Sightseeing, we depart Salzburg and continue direct to Vienna, Austria's capital and once the capital of a great empire in central Europe. Mid-to-late evening arrival in Vienna. (B)
