



NEW ZEALAND FRIENDSHIP & TENNIS TOUR

February 19 – March 3, 2008

DAILY ITINERARY:

DAY 1 – FEB 19: Depart at 2:10 PM connecting in LAX and departing for Auckland at 9:00 PM. Relax and enjoy the flights.

DAY 2 – FEB 20: Today is lost as we fly through the international dateline.

DAY 3 – FEB 21: Arrive in Auckland at 6:45 AM and transfer to ANZ 639 departing for Queenstown at 10:00 AM arriving there at 11:50AM. Your ASD guide will meet you as you exit customs, transfer to your hotel and relax. Queenstown, on the shores of Lake Wakatipu, is nestled in what is surely one of the most scenic spots in the world. It is “the” resort town of the South Island! There is a fabulous range of facilities, activities, restaurants and nightlife.

DAY 4 – FEB 22: AM breakfast at the hotel. Today we have a sightseeing tour to Walter Peak Farm. Walter Peak Farm Excursion – take a lake cruise on the stately steel-hulled TSS Earnshaw. Visit the Walter Peak Sheep Station where you will see sheepdogs and sheep shearing at the station. The evening dinner cruise is four hours long with a carvery buffet at Walter Peak. (B, D)

DAY 5 – FEB 23: AM breakfast at the hotel, the morning is free to explore on your own. **Afternoon tennis** event and early evening dinner with one of our local host tennis clubs. (B, D)

DAY 6 – FEB 24: AM breakfast at the hotel, depart for TeAnau via private coach. Afternoon tour of Milford Sound – one of New Zealand’s most famous tourist destinations. The 22 kilometer-long fiord is dominated by the beautiful 1696 meter-high Miter Peak. The calm water mirrors the sheer peaks that rise all around. The evening is free to relax and enjoy the beautiful area. (B, L)

DAY 7 – FEB 25: AM breakfast at the hotel followed by a midmorning departure by motor coach for Christchurch via Mt Cook National Park. Overnight in local motel at Mount Cook. (B)

DAY 8 – FEB 26: AM depart for Christchurch with more sightseeing at Lake Tekapo along the way. Late afternoon arrival in Christchurch, transfer to our hotel. The evening is free to explore on your own. Christchurch is often described as the most English of New Zealand’s cities. Experience the beautiful city of Christchurch perhaps visit the fascinating Canterbury Museum – one of the best regional museums anywhere, particularly interesting are the early colonist exhibits and the Antarctic discovery section. (B)

DAY 9 – FEB 27: AM breakfast at the hotel followed by a free day to explore on your own. Enjoy Cathedral Square – in the heart of Christchurch and the best place to start exploring the city. Christ Church Cathedral, consecrated in 1881, dominates the square. Afterwards enjoy a walk along the invitingly calm and picturesque Avon River. **Evening tennis event** and no host social with our local host club. (B)



DAY 10 – FEB 28: AM breakfast at the hotel followed by a free day to explore Christchurch on your own. **Afternoon inter-group tennis event with social.** (B)

DAY 11 – FEB 29: AM breakfast at the hotel followed by our flight to Auckland. Upon arrival we will transfer to our hotel. The evening is free to explore the city on your own. (B)

DAY 12 – MAR 1: AM breakfast at the hotel followed by a sightseeing tour to Rotorua including Te Puia, Thermal Village, the Polynesian Spa, the Skyline Gondola, a 900 meter gondola ride up the mountain where you will have a wonderful view of the area. and experience the Whakarewarewa with Maori cultural performances and the New Zealand Maori Arts and Crafts institute, the Agrodome Adventure Park and Paradise Valley Springs. Overnight in Rotorua. (B)

DAY 13 – MAR 2: AM breakfast at the hotel and transfer back to Auckland. **Midday tennis event and social at our local host club.** Late afternoon transfer to the Hauraki Gulf, Rangitoto Island for sightseeing. Enjoy your last evening in New Zealand, shop, sightsee or enjoy a fine dinner at one of the many restaurants in the city. (B)

DAY 14 – MAR 3: AM breakfast at the hotel. Check out and transfer to the airport for ANZ flight #6 departing at noon for LAX. Relax and enjoy the flight. Arriving at LAX at 10:25 AM the same day then transferring to home later the same day. (B, L, D)
