DAY 1 – March 22: Meet at ticket counter at Denver airport for check-in. Depart for Russia via New York and Helsinki. Relax and enjoy the flight. Meals and movies are included!!

DAY 2 – March 23: Arrival in Moscow. Upon arrival, you will be clearing customs and immigration, and transfer by private coach to our hotel in Moscow. Check-in at hotel and the rest of the day is free. Dinner at hotel.

DAY 3 – March 24: Breakfast at hotel. Morning half day Moscow Panorama Sightseeing highlighting the city as well as visit the famous Red Square and see St. Basil's Cathedral. Afternoon student program with local students followed by social get together. Dinner at hotel.

DAY 5 – March 26: Day at leisure for individual sightseeing in Moscow. After dinner, enjoy a performance of the famous Moscow Circus. Transfer to overnight train bound for St. Petersburg. Accommodation at overnight train.

DAY 6 – March 27: Morning arrival by train to St. Petersburg. Transfer to hotel for breakfast followed by half day St. Petersburg Panorama Sightseeing. Balance of the day at leisure in St. Petersburg. Dinner at hotel.

DAY 7 – March 28: Breakfast at hotel. Morning half-day Hermitage Museum visit. Afternoon/evening with local students followed by social get together. Dinner at hotel.

DAY 8 – March 29: Breakfast at hotel. Morning half-day excursion to Petrodvorets, the Summer Palace of the Czars, or Pushkin, known as Czar's Village. Afternoon/evening with local students followed by social get together. Dinner at hotel.

DAY 9 – March 30: Breakfast at hotel. Day at leisure in St. Petersburg. Evening farewell dinner with folklore entertainment.

DAY 10 – March 31: Breakfast at hotel. Morning transfer by private coach from the hotel to St. Petersburg airport for your flight home (via Helsinki and New York).
